Make sure to install Timeslips and QuickBooks on the same workstation. If you install Timeslips and QuickBooks on different workstations, TAL Pro is disabled.

Understanding Terminology

When using TAL Pro, it is important to note the following terminology differences:

Clients in Timeslips = Customers in QuickBooks
Timekeepers in Timeslips = Employees in QuickBooks
Activities in Timeslips = Items in QuickBooks

Setting up Timeslips for use with QuickBooks

When you first install TAL Pro, you must follow certain setup procedures before you can use TAL Pro.

Upgrading TAL to TAL Pro

• When you install TAL Pro, TAL features are no longer available. If you disable TAL Pro in the Features Enabled dialog box, TAL is re-enabled.

Setting up Access Rights

- The security access rights assigned to Timeslips depend on how Timeslips accesses the QuickBooks database. To prevent unauthorized or inexperienced users from performing certain functions related to TAL Pro, Timeslips offers security settings that let you establish system-wide and individual rights.
- You can establish security settings for TAL Pro in Timeslips within the Settings area of the Security Profile dialog box.

Synchronizing Names

TAL Pro enables you to synchronize names between Timeslips and QuickBooks. This process ensures that information for clients matches information for customers, and information for timekeepers matches information for employees, reducing double-entry.

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Creating Slips based on QuickBooks Transactions

QuickBooks customers use checks and bills to keep track of money they owe to vendors. TAL Pro enables you to create slips in Timeslips based on line items from checks and vendor bills in QuickBooks.

Transferring Transaction Information to QuickBooks

When approving bills in Timeslips, TAL Pro can automatically post transaction information to QuickBooks accounts, eliminating double entry.
